## Solkiki Production Capacity Upgrade

The applicant had been approached by several organisations looking to sell their chocolate but identified that they were working at capacity with their current equipment. In order to meet the new demand they needed to grow their business and improve efficiency. This project purchased core equipment that is now being used to produce white, milk and dark craft chocolate; the equipment purchased included a grinder, tempering machine and cooling racks.



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
