This project saw the purchase and installation of equipment to allow Motcombe Memorial Hall to screen live theatre and cinema. The main objective of the project was to provide the Hall with a sustainable revenue source that will support it for years to come. It was also hoped that the project will encourage visitors to the area.

The first screening, of Tosca, in February 2018 sold out and has been followed by a varied programme of screenings and pre-recorded shows from the National Theatres and opera venues. The venue is fast becoming a cultural centre for the area providing benefits for local residents, visitors and businesses.
